Come and say Goodbye to Mrs Elledge

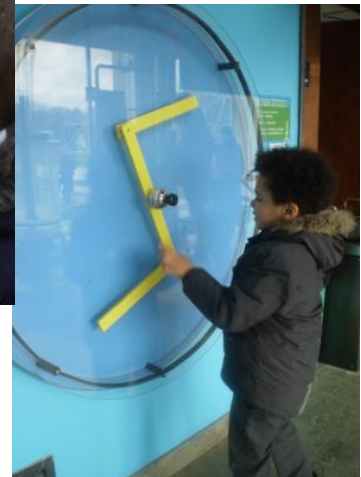

On Thursday March 14th the children in SSC1 visited The Observatory Science Centre in Herstmonceux.

They explored a range of science exhibits including how to generate power, by turning a handle to make the light come on, making shadows and creating dams in the water tray to control the flow of water. They also looked inside one of the observatories and saw the massive telescope, and how the dome opened and moved so that people could follow the stars. They particularly enjoyed using the water cycle to move water using water wheels, scoops and pumps.
