Write an information leaflet about how to care for a pet.

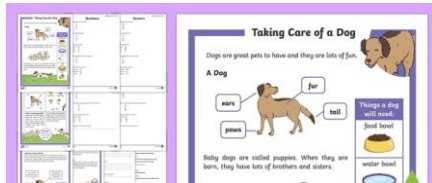
*What do they eat?*
