Term 4 Attendance

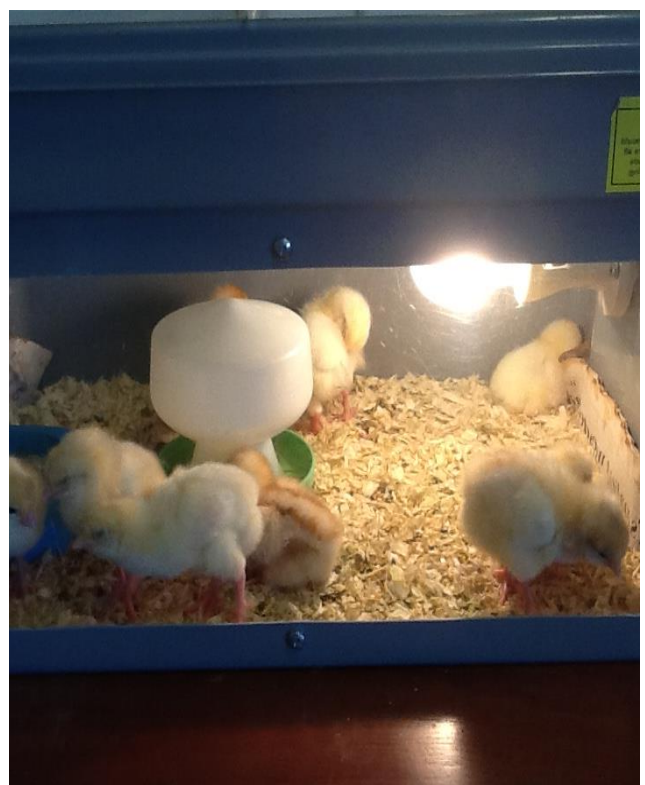
Last term the Warblers and Kingfishers had the highest percentage of attendance tying at 96.4%.

In term 4, 74 pupils were late to registration on at least one occasion. This equates to 39 hours of learning time lost during the term and 74 instances where a class already in progress was interrupted by a pupil arriving late. As you can appreciate this is not only uncomfortable for the arriving pupil, but disrupts others learning. Please ensure that your child is in the classroom at 8:55 a.m. for registration.
