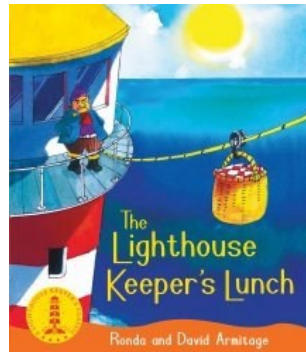
As the weather is warming up, please ensure your child has a named hat and a water bottle at school and that you have applied sun cream before they come to school.



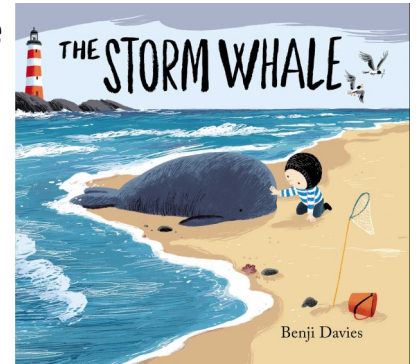
Oh I do Like to be Beside the Seaside

For our final term of year 2, we will be looking at two books, *The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch* by Ronda and David Armitage and *The Storm Whale* by Benji Davies. Our English focus, will be reading and creating our own Instructional texts and Explanation texts based on elements from in these books.

We will be linking the texts into our topic work through History, Science, DT and Art. In History, we will be looking at changes in beaches and beach holidays from the past to present. In Science, we will be researching a range of animals you can find in and around the sea and the natural features of their environment. We will be investigating levers and other ways of lifting heavy loads. For DT, we will be looking at creating our own systems to make a lunch box. In Art, we will be doing a few art projects like making rubbings from shells and rocks found at the beach, and looking at patterns in nature. In P.E. we are continuing to focus on a variety of bat and ball games and focussing on team spirit on the run up to sports day.
