### Spelling Strategy of the week

#### Colour Blocking

This is a method for visual learners. Colour block the letters EXACTLY as YOU want – it does not need to match either the syllables or the sounds.

A parent, carer or friend can draw the shapes of three words you are learning and see if you can work out which shape represents each word before writing in the letters on the blank shapes to spell each word.
