Sunflower Lanyards and JAM Cards



In October Southeastern are launching a trial for customers in the Tonbridge to Hastings area.



Just a minute The green sunflower lanyard is for customers who have a hidden disability. The idea is that by wearing one the person is letting people know they may need some extra help.

The JAM card (Just a Minute) is a card or is also available as an App, for customers who have any hidden disabilities and may need a bit more time and patience. By showing the card they are letting people know they may need some extra time or something explained in greater detail.

They are available to collect from Tonbridge, High Brooms, Tunbridge Wells, Frant, Wadhurst, Stonegate, Etchngham, Robertsbridge, Battle, Crowhurst, West St Leonards, St Leonards Warrior Square and Hastings stations.
