#### **REMINDERS**

#### **ENGLISH**

In English this term, we will be reading the text "Man on the Moon" by Simon Bartram. The children will explore Bob's daily routine as a caretaker and tour guide on the moon. The children will use their inference skills to

identify that the illustrations and the text are telling two different stories.

We will be focusing on developing our sentence structure and editing skills as well as beginning to add a range of suffixes.



#### **MATHS**

We will begin the term with the new topic of fractions. Children will be learning to understand wholes and equal parts. They will then move on to explore a range of fractions, identifying and finding halves, quarters and thirds. Children will also learn about the difference between unit and non-unit fractions as well as counting in fractions beyond 1 whole.

Later on in the term children will then move on to look at statistics and geometry. We will look at data handling and analysing the data which they collect as well as exploring shape

### **LEARNING JOURNEY FOCUS**

Our learning journey topic is 'Out of this World'. Children will be exploring this through history. They will be learning about the life of a significant individual who has contributed to international achievements and a significant event: Neil Armstrong and the Moon landing!

In science this term, the children will be learning about everyday materials. Children will have a number of opportunities for scientific enquiry and will be leaning to record their results in a variety of ways.

Please ensure that your child brings a full P.E kit which is labelled with their name in the first day of term. The focus this term will be dance.

RE

In RE this term children will be learning about the life of young Jesus.

#### **PSHEE**

In PSHEe this term, the children will be learning about their feelings and emotions and also the importance of valuing difference.
