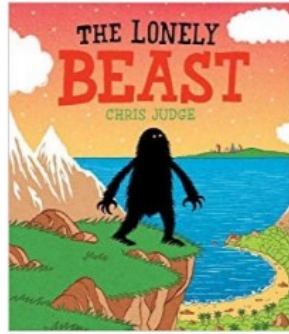
REMINDER ABOUT UNIFORM



Please remember that all children need to wear a tie and plain black school shoes - this includes the sole of the shoe.

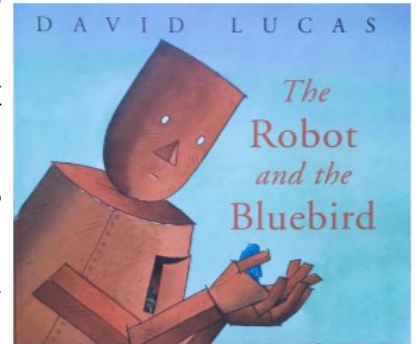
World Book Day

This term we will be using 2 texts to support our learning across the curriculum called 'The Robot and the Bluebird' by David Lucas and 'The Lonely Beast' by Chris Judge. We will be linking this to learning about materials in Science and friendships in PSHE. We will also be creating some moving robot models using junk modelling during DT. We will be writing and recording sounds in music and looking at continents on the world map to help gain an understanding of the world.



HOME LEARNING
