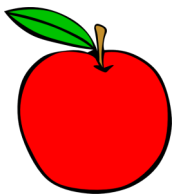

Please make sure your child has a water bottle in school, so they can keep hydrated during lessons.



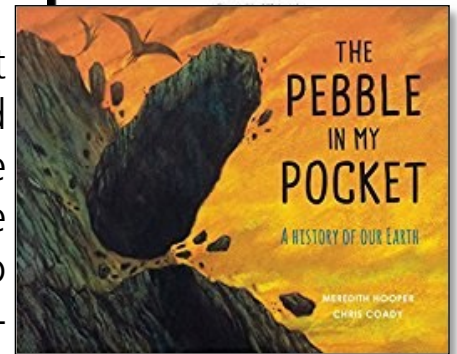
Snacks
