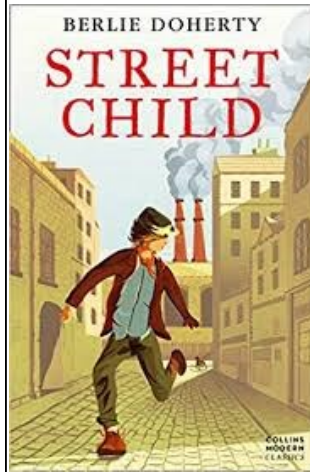

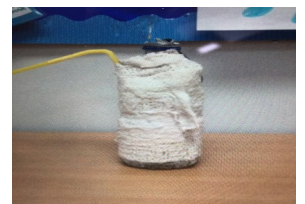
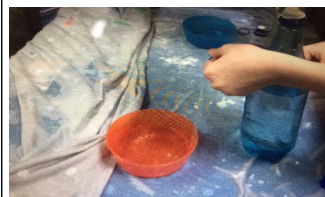
Please continue to attempt our termly homework tasks - we are looking forward to seeing all of your exciting projects!
