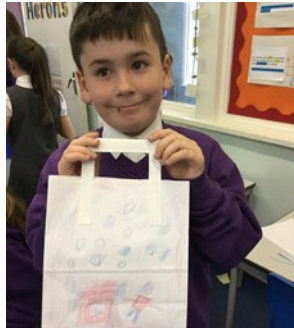
## CHILDREN IN NEED
