### Wild!

This term we will be basing our learning around the text 'Wild' by Emily Hughes.

The book is about a little girl who grows up in the wild. The reader finds out what happens when some grown ups take her home and try to make her civilised!

In science we will be looking at plants and animals. We will explore different ways to categorise them and will look at the structure of plants.

We will look at maps and atlases to find wild places on the earth, and will practise using directional language in maths and geography.

We will explore using different mediums in art to create a variety of effects, looking at patterns and textures from the wild. We will also look at the work of William Morris and how he used flowers and leaves to create patterns. We will learn some songs around the subject of 'Wild'.

In RE we will encourage children to begin to think about their own beliefs. In PSHE we will learn about rules for personal protection and how we change from birth to five.

### HOME LEARNING

Please read with your child each day and talk about the stories you share.

Please help your child to learn their spellings each week. As well as using the 'look, cover, write, check' method, it may help your child to try writing the words within a short sentence.

### URBAN EXPLORERS!

Last term the children really enjoyed our book 'Claude in the City'. We had a lovely trip to the Old Town and developed our map making skills!
