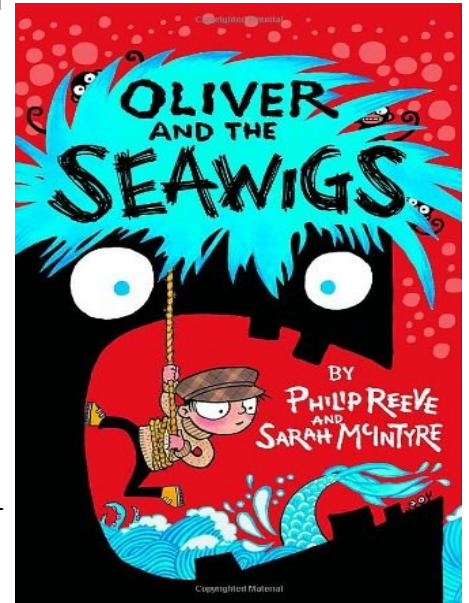
SUMMER SEAWIGS
