

Our Learning

In maths the children will learn about number and shape through a range of practical experiences. They will take part in a Number Hunt around the Academy. We will count in a variety of contexts and explore 2d shapes. There will be lots of opportunities for the children to follow their own mathematical interests both inside and in the outdoor learning environment.



In literacy this term we will be immersing ourselves in lots of stories, such as Owl Babies, Sssh and The Naughty Bus. We will be acting out stories, exploring characters and even hope to meet a real owl. We will begin our daily letters and sounds experiences this term. We will use our senses to learn about phonics.

Please can we ask for your patience with dismissal at the end of each day. We will bring the children in to the garden in groups, but they need to wait to be sent to you by the teacher. This will ensure their safe-
