ParentPay and Meal Ordering Service

Launch Date:- Monday 27th November

If you have not done so already, please log into ParentPay as soon as possible. If you are having problems with logging on please speak to Mrs Prince who is available every day in the community room between 9-9.30am.

It is essential that all parents register even if your child is entitled to a free school meal. All parents will need to order their child's meal by midnight the day before. If you have not registered you will not be able to pay for or order a meal, as the school office will no longer accept cash payments.
