INCY WINCY SPIDER AND OTHER NURSERY RHYMES

This term children will be learning to sing and recite familiar nursery rhymes. They will learn new words and begin to explore rhythm and rhyme. They will continue to recognise and copy some of the letters in their names. They will use pencils and other mark-making tools to draw and recreate nursery rhyme characters and events.

In mathematics, the children will use number names in sequence. They will learn to count objects in groups and sometimes match a group with the correct numeral. Children will use and identify shapes in their pictures and models.

As Christmas approaches, the children will begin preparations, making cards and decorations to take home. We will encourage them to talk about their experiences of Christmas and other important festivals. Nursery children will take part in our Nativity performance and we hope you will come along to this musical celebration.
