Join us on our exciting learning journey...  
**'How does your garden grow'**

Our Learning Journey this term will see us learning all about plants and growth. The pupils will be observing and describing how seeds grow into mature plants and exploring what plants need to grow and stay healthy.

#### English

In English this term, the pupils will be using their science knowledge to plan and write their own non-chronological report.

Later on in the term, the pupils will be writ-


ing a 'tale of fear' based on the well known traditional tale 'Jack and the Beanstalk.

#### Maths

In Maths this term the children will begin by consolidating their learning about money. Including adding amounts and calculating change.

After this, the children will explore time. The children will learn how to tell and write the time to five minutes, including 'half past' 'quarter past' and 'quarter to'.

Following on from our learning about time, we will be learning about fractions. The children will learn to recognise, find, name and write fractions  $\frac{1}{3}$ ,  $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $\frac{2}{4}$ , and  $\frac{3}{4}$ .



### Learning Journey continued

#### Science

This term, our Science topic is plants and growth. The pupils will be growing their own seeds to explore how seeds grow.

#### DT

In DT we will be designing and making our own healthy salad bowls.

#### Geography

In Geography this term, the pupils will be learning to use simple compass directions and locational and directional language to describe the location and features and routes on a map.



#### RE

In RE this term, the pupils will be learning and exploring Christian baptism.

#### Music

In music, the pupils will be exploring sounds and beats
