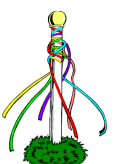

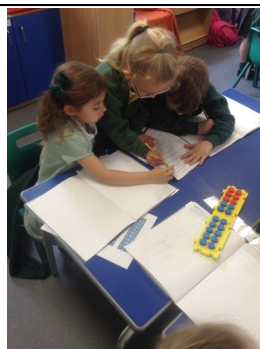
Artwork being shown includes the children's personal journey sticks as well as a large group mural painted onto fabric exploring artistically what Spring means for children.
