We have been using ParentPay as the system for ordering a school dinner now for 6 months. The system has been successful in ensuring that children get the meal of your choice and reducing the incidents of lost money. The Academy is not responsible for the ordering or payment of any meals. From half term the Academy expects all parents to order meals in advance themselves - Mrs Prince will no longer be able to support you with this. All meals must be ordered before 12am the day before the meal is required. **ANY CHILD WHOSE MEAL HAS NOT BEEN ORDERED BY THIS TIME WILL BE GIVEN A SLICE OF BREAD AND A DRINK ONLY.** If your child is absent please ensure that you cancel the order before 8.30am otherwise you will still be charged.
