## AUTUMN LESSON OBSERVATION FEEDBACK

### 5 MAIN STRENGTHS ACROSS THE ACADEMY

- Planning demonstrated differentiated tasks for all children to be challenged and supported. Pupil voice evidenced that children felt challenged and knew what to do if stuck.
- Quality and interaction of Learning Walls has improved dramatically. Evidence of children's involvement with this process included whiteboards and post-it notes.
- All teachers have made a good start at setting high expectations. Successful lessons have included pacy 'ping pong' learning, which included teachers and children.
- Learning environment contains clear and tidy working areas with non-negotiable displays up.
- Consistency across year groups in planning and work.

### 2 MAIN AREAS OF IMPROVEMENT ACROSS THE ACADEMY

- To consider the content of the weekly plan. Identify opportunities to celebrate our values, reflection on the learning and identify groups within the class. Most successful lessons considered these elements.
- Clearly identify the learning intention and the steps to success when planning. Clearly communicate this to the children.
