
STAY AND PLAY

This term we will be exploring under and over the water! We will be experimenting with water, floating and sinking and discovering what lurks beneath!

We will be sharing lots of super stories, starting with 'Sharing a Shell'. This is all about a tiny crab who loves his new shell and doesn't want to share, until he realises he needs his friends in the rock pool. Our literacy focus will be on rhyming words and the children hearing a rhyming string. Have a go at home and share on one of the 'Wow Slips' available in the corridor.

This is a busy term, getting ready for transitions and an exciting time for the children. We will be supporting the children through activities getting them ready for their next phase in education. Transition information will follow, in the meantime the Puffins will continue to share reception resources at playtimes, use the hall and library and will be exploring the canteen with their packed lunches to ensure they are familiar and confident in their surroundings.

HOME LEARNING

We know the children at nursery are fabulously independent at toileting and putting on their coats. In those moments where you have time, encourage the children to dress and undress themselves, they will find getting ready for PE IN September so much easier. Another story we will focus on this term is The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch, he takes sandwiches to work each day. We will be making our own sandwiches, focussing on healthy choices and using knives and cutlery safely. Have a go at home and as always let us know.

We explored our community and the people that help us. We looked after the animals at the vets, learned that we need to brush our teeth twice a day and visit the dentist.
