

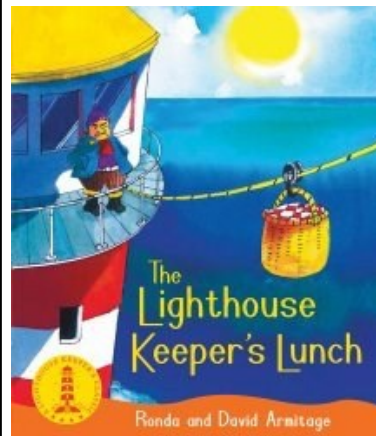

As the weather is warming up, please ensure your child has a hat and a water bottle at school. Please ensure they come to school with sun cream already applied. Thank you for your help with this.

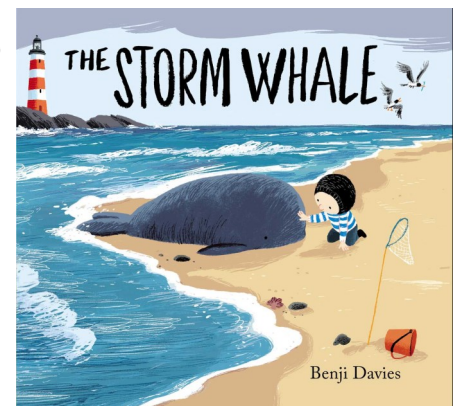


### OH I DO LIKE TO BE BESIDE THE SEASIDE

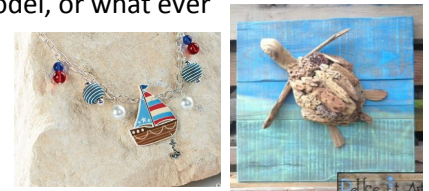
