### MOVING ON UP

**PSHEe:** In PSHEe this term the topics will be 'Taking Care of the Environment' and 'Money'. The pupils will carry out a series of exciting activities to develop their knowledge of finance, budgeting and entrepreneurship. The pupils will also design and create an exciting enterprise project to help them understand how businesses work. The pupils will also have focus on Relationships and Sex education as part of their PSHEe learning. There will be a parent/carer meeting to find out more about this unit at

**English:** In English this term the pupils will be developing their creative writing skills by exploring warning stories. The pupils will be introduced to the short story The Canal and use the story as inspiration for their stories. The pupils will also read the text Stormbreaker alongside the unit, looking closely at how writers develop characters and settings effectively to engage the reader. The pupils will also look at per-

suasion this term; focusing on debating skills, before moving onto creating leaflets with a focus in their transition to secondary school.

**Science:** This term's Science learning will have a focus on working scientifically. Each week the pupils will develop their enquiry skills by planning and carrying out an investigation linked to the different topics that they have studied this term. They will need to make predictions, carry out practical experiments as well as ensuring that they are recording and analyzing their findings effectively.




### Maths
