

Cookies Policy

Introduction

The Trust uses cookies on its website and on each academy's website. This Cookies Policy explains what cookies are, how the Trust uses cookies and how users of the website can control cookies.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored by the browser (eg Internet Explorer or Safari) on your computer or mobile device. They allow websites to remember your actions and preferences (such as display preferences) and make your next visit easier.

How does the Trust use cookies on its websites?

The Trust uses cookies to collect the following information:

- the browser types and versions used to access the Trust's websites
- the operating system used by the accessing system
- the website from which an accessing system reaches the Trust's website (so-called referrers)
- the sub-websites
- the date and time of access to the website
- an Internet protocol address (IP address)
- the Internet service provider of the accessing system
- other similar and information that may be used in the event of attacks on our information technology systems.

When using this data and information, the Trust does not draw any conclusions about the individual (or data subject) using the website. It uses this information for the following purposes:

- To personalise the content of the website
- To deliver the content of the website correctly
- To provide social media features
- To optimise the content of the website
- To share information about the use of the website with analytic partners
- To ensure the long-term viability of information technology systems and website technology
- To provide law enforcement authorities with the information necessary for criminal prosecution in case of a cyber-attack.

The Trust analyses anonymously collected data and information statistically, with the aim of increasing data protection and data security, and to ensure an optimal level of protection for the personal data being processed. The anonymous data of the server log files are stored separately from all personal data provided by a data subject.

How can users of the Trust's websites control cookies?

Use of the Trust's website is possible without the use of cookies.

Users of the website are invited to 'Accept Cookies' when they access the website for the first time. Cookies can be deleted by visiting the browser's help pages.
