In Summer term we had a Pupil Premium Review carried out by two National Leaders of Education. They spent a day in school, looking at teaching, assessment, talking to the children and evaluating the effectiveness of our PP spend. They concluded that the children received good value for money. There was a dedicated Pupil Premium Champion and evidence of quality first teaching and a wide range of enrichment and aspirational activities for the children to access. They concluded that we should continue the good work in place and look to lay on some English and Maths workshops to help you support the children at home as this was an area the children had flagged. We will endeavour to roll some of these out next year.
