English

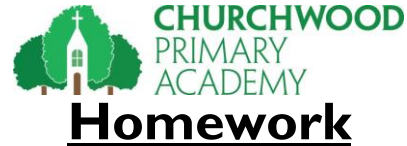
Write a recount of an event or a day out that you have enjoyed.

Art

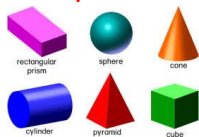
Create an artwork to show a tree in each of the 4 seasons.
