Our Learning Journey

'Once Upon a Time'

This term we will be reading a selection of familiar and traditional tales. We will start the term off with 'Owl Babies' before moving on to reading 'The Gingerbread Man' and 'The Little Red Hen'. We will talk about who the characters are, the story settings and joining in with the repetitive phrases. We will read our favourite fairy tales and make up our own! At the end of the term we will be celebrating the Harvest Festival. You are invited to come along and enjoy some yummy home made bread and soup!

Concept cat

Each week we will be learning a new concept. This could be related to size, shape, time,



weight, etc. We use a cuddly cat called Concept Cat to teach the children about the concept. We will act out a story with Concept Cat before consolidating our learning with a fun game.

Word aware

Each week we will have two words that we will be learning. These words will link to the key text that we are looking at that week. We will explore the words in our Key Groups, exploring what the word means, how to say it and how it is used. This is all done through different games and activities which are mirrored within the provision for the children to access freely to consolidate the learning of these words.

Rhyme of the week

Alongside our Story of the Week we will also learn a new rhyme. This is displayed to allow you to learn the rhyme at home with your children!

Badger Registration.

All children who arrive for a 9am or 12pm start will need to enter the nursery through the Nursery garden door.

Morning children are welcome to wait within the garden from 8.50am. Please wait until a member of staff opens the door at 9am for the children to enter.

The signing in sheet will be placed outdoors for you to sign your child in. We encourage the children to enter the Nursery inde-

pendently, saying goodbye to you in the garden. The children's pegs will be displayed on a daily basis, staff will be waiting to greet the children and help them with their belongings.

If your child starts or finishes their session at 12pm then please wait outside the gate.

A member of staff will be out at 12pm to dismiss and welcome the children in. All children whose session ends at 3pm will be dismissed to you in

the garden. Please wait in the garden for the children. If you would like to speak to a member of staff then we ask that you please wait until all the children have been welcomed in or dismissed. Alternatively you are welcome to contact us by e-mail or telephone.
