

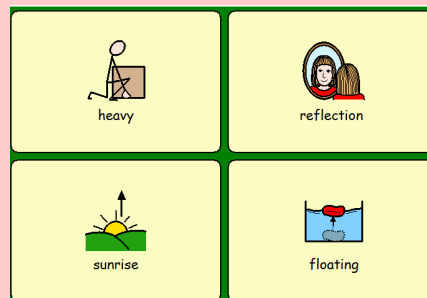


## Dear Parents and Carers 12.11.18
