Learning Journey

This week in Science the children are learning to identify whether things are alive, dead or have never lived. In PSHE the children are learning to ask for help if they are worried about something by identify who can help them. In Art, the children are learning to make textured collages using folding, crumpling and tearing of materials. In RE the children are learning to discuss their own ideas about God. In PE the children are learning to master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching.

Maths

This week in Maths the children will be continuing their unit on addition and subtraction. The children will be learning to add a one-digit number to a two-digit number, including when exchanging is required.

English

This week in English the children will be learning to identify the features of a poem. The children will be creating their own poem, using punctuation for effect, powerful vocabulary and lists of three verbs or adjectives for impact.

Letters and Sounds

This week in Letters and Sounds the children will be learning to add the suffix -ing -ed and -er to verbs. The children will practice reading and writing verbs with the suffices in sentences.

Reading

The week the children are reading "A Mammoth Task" and practicing predicting. It is really important to emphasise to your child that predicting is not about making a guess but using information from the text so far to make a statement about what might happen next.
