<p>Design a game to help children learn their times tables.</p> <p><i>You may focus on one times table, but make sure it is one that will help your learning!</i></p> <p style="text-align: right;"><input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Write a narrative (story) set in 1066 (<u>1 page or more</u>) Use tension techniques to create tension and maintain the reader's interest throughout.
