Science

Draw a diagram of your house/home. Label the parts and the materials used to build your home i.e. glass windows, plastic drainpipes etc.

Art

Create pictures of different styles of homes from around the world.

History

Interview an older family member or friend to find out about how houses have changed over time.

Possible questions-

*Did you have a bathroom?
Did you have a television in your house?
Was your bathroom the same as it is today?
How have homes changed since you were a child?*

Maths.

Draw a street of houses.

Colour the front doors- all the odd house numbers **red** and the even house numbers **blue**.
