Welcome back to Term 4!

English

In English we will be introducing our new text 'Zeraffa Giraffa' and begin to understand how the characters in the story might be feeling. Next we will be choosing good vocabulary to describe giraffes in their natural habitat. Pupils will be writing letters to the Pasha discussing whether or not Zeraffa should be sent to France. Finally the pupils will be discussing what they could hear, smell or feel if they were in the book.

Destination Reader

In reading we are learning to engage with and discuss the text. We are learning to make plausible predictions based on clues from the text.

This week we will be reading 'Sleep.'

Maths

In maths we are learning to describe and sort 2D shapes including counting the number of sides and vertices. Pupils will learn that vertices are the number of corners a shape has. Pupils will also learn to understand the terms polygon and quadrilateral. We will end the week by learning to find lines of symmetry in 2D shapes.
