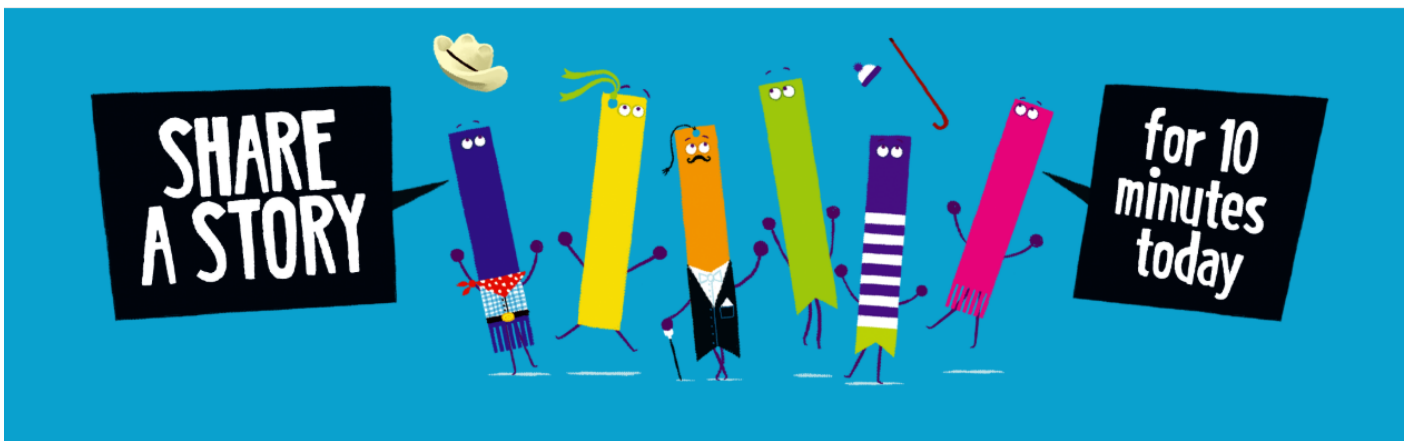
Children are invited to come in as a book character and bring in a story book that they would like to share with their friends during the day.

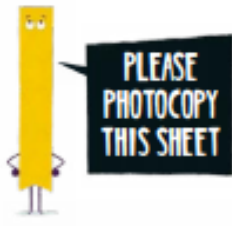


# ARE YOU A SHARE A STORY READING STAR?
